

The Problem: Chrome no longer supports Adobe Acrobat Reader.

The Solution: Change your preferences in your Chrome browser.


Changing your preferences is simple and should only take about a minute. Here are the steps.

(1) First, make sure that you already have Adobe Reader. If you don't, you can download it for free at: <http://www.adobe.com/products/reader.html>


The remaining steps are done in your Chrome browser.

(2) In the address bar of Chrome, type "chrome://plugins".

(3) On the screen that then appears, disable the Chrome PDF viewer. (When it is disabled, the 'enable' command will be visible, and the entire area for the Chrome PDF viewer will be gray.



(4) When you select a PDF form from the web page, the name of the form should appear at the bottom of your browser window. (The example used here is the Non-Title V Permit Renewal form.)



(5) To open the form, click on the arrow to the right of the downloaded form. Select 'Open'. The form will then open in Acrobat Reader.
